1. Reset

[SETTINGS], [DOWN], [DOWN], [OK],
[DOWN], [DOWN], [OK], [OK]

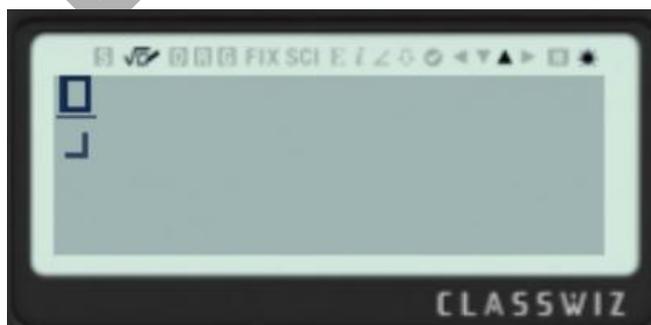
2. Mode 68

[SETTINGS], [DOWN], [DOWN], [OK],
[DOWN], [DOWN], [OK], { [OK] then
press [ON] after 0.5 seconds }

3. Basic Overflow

{ Optional press [SETTINGS], [DOWN],
[OK], [DOWN], [DOWN], [OK], [OK] to
see what you have pressed }

[5], [FRACTION], [6], [OK],
[SETTINGS], [OK], [OK], [OK],
[HOME], [OK], [UP], [LEFT], [DEL],
[LEFT], [DEL], [FRACTION]



6. Get unstable [>]

{Go behind the Line1/Line0 fraction}, [CATALOG], [DOWN], [OK], [UP], [UP], [OK], [LEFT], [LEFT], [RIGHT], [CATALOG], [DOWN], [OK], [UP], [UP], [OK], [RIGHT], [RIGHT], [RIGHT], [DEL], [DEL], [RIGHT], [>], [RIGHT], [RIGHT], [DEL], [DEL], [1], [7], [RIGHT], [1], [+], [OK], [OK], {106 random numbers}, [FRACTION], [AC]

Spam characters to get a cool effect that saves even when [AC] is pressed {E.G Fraction, Numbers, Square Root}
